## ALL PARTICIPANTS

The CLIOHWORLD final Plenary Meeting will take place in Lisbon, on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> of June, at the campus of the Faculty of Social and Human Sciences (FCSH) of NOVA University of Lisbon (<u>www.fcsh.unl.pt</u>).

All participants will be accommodated at the

Holiday Inn Lisbon-Continental, Rua Laura Alves, 9, 1069-169 Lisboa, www.holidayinn.com, located at a 3 minute walking distance from the Plenary Meeting venue (see map).

The Lisbon airport (www.ana.pt) is located very close to the city centre. The best way to go from the airport to the Hotel is to take the Lisbon Airport AeroBus/AirShuttle(see attached brochure).

The bus stop is located outside the airport, just in front of the Arrivals Hall.

The ticket can be bought on board and costs 3,5 euro.

This ticket is valid for all urban public transport for 24 hours.

The CLIOHWORLD participants should leave the AeroBus at the bus stop "Campo Pequeno", a square easily recognizable because it has a bullring built in neo-Moorish style. From there just go straight along the sidewalk, cross the avenue at the traffic lights and the Hotel is the second building on the left after a big pink building (see map).

Another way to go from the airport to the hotel is by taxi, which can be taken when leaving the Arrivals Hall or else by going to the exit of the Departures Hall of the airport. The trip will cost around 7 euros. A fee will be charged for the luggage and the trips between 9:00pm and 7:00am will also have an additional fee of 20% of the cost of the trip. Pisa cannot reimburse taxi travel.

Returning to the airport for departure can be easily accomplished by using the airport bus / shuttle from the "Campo Pequeno" bus stop, near the square with the Bullring [see attached leaflet)

In June, the weather in Lisbon is usually hot and dry, although it may be windy in the late afternoon.
